## SPEAKER PA SYSTEM

This public address (PA) system includes a portable speaker, 2 wireless mics, 2 wireless mic holders, 1 lapel transmitter, 1 headset transmitter, 1 wireless receiver, 1 remote, microphone cable, batteries, and power cord.

A 6-foot Pyle Pro speaker stand is also available through the Makerspace. The PA system can be used with or without the speaker stand.

The Speaker PA System is available as pickup at WVLS; it cannot be transported through courier.
